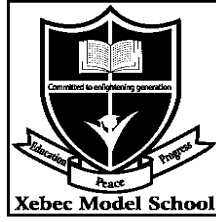

6. For writing matching phrases from right must be matched with those of left side. Otherwise, marks will be cut down accordingly.
7. For appropriate Table, List 100% marks will be given.
8. Fill in the blank, True-False: The main sentence is to be written in the answer script, otherwise 50% marks will be cut down.

1. Broad Question: If the answer is written properly without mistake, 95% marks will be given. But if the answer is written from own ideas with reference of other books with beautiful handwriting, 100% marks can be awarded.
2. Short Question: If the answer is appropriate and accurate, 100% marks can be given for the answer written without reference.
3. Al Hadith / Surah etc: If the translation and pronunciation is correct, 100% marks can be given.
4. Objective Type Question: For the right answer, 100% marks will be given. Partial mark is not acceptable.
5. For any spelling mistake, 0.5 marks would be cut down, for 3 mistakes 1 mark will be cut down.
6. For grammatical mistake, marks will be cut down as per choice of the teacher.

Guidelines for the Evaluation of Answer Scripts

- 01. Multiple Choice:** 100% marks should be awarded for selecting and writing the best alternative. In case of confusion, among the alternatives, incumbent teachers' decision will be final.
- 02. Word Making:** 100% marks should be awarded for writing the appropriate word with correct spelling. Fifty percent marks should be deducted if the spelling mistake is found, but in this case, the meaning of the word must not be changed.
- 03. Filling in the gaps:** 100% marks should be awarded for writing the appropriate word with correct spelling.
- 04. Sentence Making:** 100% marks should be awarded for writing the correct and appropriate sentences. The marks shall be zero (00) if any grammatical mistake is found. Fifty percent marks shall be deducted if any punctuation marks is wrongly used or not put down at all
- 05. Matching:** Correct matching of words or parts of sentences shall be awarded 100% marks. Otherwise marks will be zero.
- 06. Paragraph:**
 - a. 70% of the allotted marks shall be rewarded. The paragraph must be written in one paragraph.
 - b. If the paragraph is written more than one paragraph in that case, the marking must be zero. For every three mistakes (spelling, punctuation, the use of capital and small letters).
- 07. Letter / Application:**
 - a. Letters written excluding the body shall be marked zero.
 - b. The highest limit of marking shall be 70%.
 - c. Letters written irrelevantly shall carry no marks. For three mistakes (spelling, punctuation, the use of capital and small letters) one mark shall be deducted.
 - d. 20% of he allotted marks shall be awarded for relevantly of the subject matter.
- 08. Capitalization / Punctuation:**

Correct answer shall be awarded 100% marks.
Incorrect answer shall be given zero.

09. Short Questions:

- a. The highest limit of marking is seventy five percent. Irrelevant answers shall be marked zero (00). For every three mistakes (spelling, punctuation, the use of capital and small letter etc.) one mark shall be deducted. Grammatical accuracy shall have to be maintained strictly. In case of having no alternative answer to any question, hundred percent marks shall be awarded.
- b. If any answer is written excess in that case no marks shall be deducted. But if the answer is repeated, in that case, only equivalent marks of the same answer should be deducted.
- c. If the same spelling mistake recurs in the same answer, in that case, only the first three mistakes shall be calculated as mistake of words.

10. Rhymes/ Poem: The highest limit of marking is hundred percent. For every mistake (spelling, punctuation mark, the use of capital and small letter etc.) one mark shall be deducted. But the deduction must not exceed limit of eighty percent of the total marks.

11. Grammar:

- a. In this grammatical accuracy shall have to be followed strictly and the violation of the norm shall be fully penalized. In case of filling up the gaps, full sentence should be written.
- b. Hundred percent marks shall be awarded if the answer is correct.

12. Translation / Retranslation: Hundred percent marks shall be awarded for writing correct translation / retranslation. Fifty percent marks shall be deducted for punctuation and spelling mistakes.

13. Fill in with / with our clues etc: In case of filling up the gaps sentence with appropriate word / words after the text, hundred percent marks shall be awarded. But in case of violation of the said norm, marks shall be zero (00).

14. Spelling and dictation: In case of having no mistake in writing spelling and dictation, hundred percent marks shall be awarded. If any grammatical mistake is found; the marks shall be zero (00).

N.B. If any problem arises beyond the scope of the above noted guide lines, in that case the decision taken by the authority shall be treated as decisive.

05. Bring the Guardian's Collection Card to drop and pick up your child.

06. Don't give any fancy materials or gift to your child to school.
07. Check the Diary every day, sign and comment on the pointed place.
08. Directly contact with the Class Teacher, Vice Principal or Principal for any complain or suggestion. Don't do it with other guardian/s.
09. Attend all the Guardian's Meeting.
10. Read, respond and sign all the notices.
11. Inform everything regarding your child timely. Specially his/her leave or absence or sickness (Directly, Over phone or Messenger group).
12. Don't take any leave during Tutorial Test or Examination.
13. Guardians would kindly write down their identity and put their specimen signature in the diary. House tutors, uncles or elder brothers are not accepted as guardian.
14. When your ward is back home please check his/her diary and find out the lessons imparted in different periods. If you have anything to say, please write in the remarks column and put your signature at the below of the page.
15. Have a look at the assignments given for the next day and encourage them to prepare those.
16. Ensure whether your son/daughter comes to XEBEC regularly and punctually in the working days and returns home in due time.
17. Guardians have to ensure their ward's presence in the Class Tests, Monthly Tests and Term End Exams.
18. Guardians must go through the rules and advice set for the students in the school diary or in the syllabus and ask their wards to abide by those and assist them in this regard.
19. The guardians should keep in touch with the class teacher regarding the studies and conduct of their wards. (As per pen picture)

Promotion Policy

02. The pass percentage for individual classes will be as under:

05. Level VI to VIII	–	60% of the total marks
06. Level IX & X	–	55% of the total marks
3. If a student misses any exam due to genuine sickness/ injury/accident/ admission to hospital/placed in bed rest, the marks of subjects shall be calculated basing on the mark obtained in any other term.

4. If any student misses exam without valid reason/ without approval from the authority, she / he shall not be awarded any mark for the subject missed.
5. Re-exam will never be conducted for the student who misses exams.
6. Any student failing in one subject shall not be promoted. She / he may be kept in the same class with the request of parent.
7. Students failing in more than one subject shall be given T.C.
8. Student failing in the same class for consecutive two years shall be given T.C.
9. Subject teachers shall initiate cases of weak students for onward transmission to parents.
10. Weak students must be taken care of separately by the subject teachers through extra classes after the normal academic periods.
11. Average marks for each subject shall be calculated with the addition of CT & term end exam.

Discipline Policy

01. Separate discipline committee shall be formed by Principal for the tenure of one year for junior and senior sections.
02. Basing on the recommendation of the discipline committee, Principal will take decision against defaulter.
03. Any student causing injury to another student which requires admission to hospital shall be given suspension for a period, not more than two weeks.
04. Any student scolding anyone or using abusive language/offensive remarks shall receive warning letter. Repetition of same offence shall warrant one week suspension.
05. Any student who steals/cheats shall be given T.C.
06. Any student adopting unfair means in any exam (CT/Term Exam) shall be given T.C.
07. Any student disobeying teachers shall get a letter of warning. Repetition of same offence shall warrant suspension.
08. Any student failing to adhere to XEBEC instructions shall be warned.
09. Any student found developing illicit relationship with any other person, shall be given TC.

10. Any student writing offensive words on any wall shall be warned.
11. Any student who is proved to be involved in anti state activities possessing explosives, ammunitions, illegal papers etc shall be given TC.
12. Any student if caught possessing any expensive electrical devices (MP3 players/Mobiles) shall be warned and the items will be seized.
13. Any student failing to report in time shall not be allowed to enter the school.
14. Any student seen with another student of opposite gender (from Level V-X) in any isolated place will be warned.
15. Any student leaving the school premises without permission from the authority will be issued with a warning letter. Repetition of same offence shall warrant suspension for two weeks.
16. Any student failing to pay tuition fee successively for three months shall have to take re-admission.

General Rules of XEBEC

07. Before joining XEBEC ensure the following
 - a. Shoes are cleaned and coloured.
 - b. Dress is clean, tidy and ironed properly.
 - c. Have a proper haircut.
 - d. Girls hair is tied with white ribbon in two pony tails braided. Nails of your finger are properly trimmed.
 - e. Girls are not wearing ear top, any fancy watch and hair clips.
 - f. Only ear ring is allowed. Have bath in morning and also brushed your teeth properly.
 - g. You do not visit roadside shops.
08. Before joining class ensure the following:
 - Have prepared your lessons for the day.
 - Have completed the home assignments.
 - Don’t move around in Verandah/Corridor during class hour.
 - Use the wash room earmarked for respective class.

05. While visiting wash room, ensure:

- a. Have flushed it before leaving the toilet.
- b. If it is not cleaned by flushing, make sure that enough water is poured and got it cleaned.

No sprinkle water in the wash room is used to avoid accident.

06. Senior students to be addressed as:

- c. Male students must be very formal with their female class mates. Under no circumstances any one can afford to be funny with them. The relationship with them will be cordial but formal. They should be treated like your own sisters. Any complaint from any girl will be considered as an offence and will be dealt with severely.

07. Behavior with class mates, seniors & juniors:

- a) Remember, that students are from different backgrounds & from different areas of the country are classmates.
- b) Every human being is different from other, some body may be emotional, irritable or unsocial but everyone should try to behave ideally.
- c) For minor things do not start quarrelling.
- d) Remember – beating, grouping & hooliganism can never solve any problem, rather it breeds the problem.
- e) For any problem in the school – may it be a misunderstanding with any classmate or any problem of oneself – bring it to the knowledge of the class teacher.

08. XEBEC Property:

Important Information about Exam

- Students must take seat in the exam room 30 minutes before the start of the exam.
- The exam will be conducted according to the time specified in the question.
- Same answer sheet will be used for both CQ and MCQ tests.

- The examinees will collect their admit card from the head of their respective institute at least three days before the commencement of the examination.
- The answer sheet can be folded in no circumstances.
- An examinee must put a signature against each subject.
- Each candidate will only be able to participate in the examination on the subject / subjects as described in the registration form.
- None but the secretary of center can use mobile at exam center and examinees will not be allowed to bring mobile phone at the center.

The Activities the Examinees Should Perform During Examination

- **To be tension free in the examination room.**
The examinees should try to be tension free and normal because, many known question answers cannot be written properly due excessive tension.
- **To use margin in the answer script.**
It is better to start writing keeping one inch margin to the top, bottom and left of the answer script, the answer script should not be folded in any case.
- **The activities to do after getting the question paper.**
At first, the question paper should be read attentively. If a map is drawn about how to start and finish the answer, the exam will be easier.
- **To keep the answer script neat and clean.**
To obtain good marks, over writing, unclear writing should be avoided. It is better to start the next question answer on the next page completing one question answer.
- **Language and spelling of the answers.**
Spellings of the answers must be accurate. Sentence structures of the answers should be easy and simple. So, the answers should not be prolonged unnecessarily.

- **To revise the answer-script at the end of writing.**

The final 10 / 15 minutes should be kept for revision. This time, it should be checked whether there is any mistakes or any answer to be unwritten.
